Scheme & Community Support Service

ateb's scheme and community support service provides housing related support for tenants age 55+.

The service is funded through Supporting People Payment Grant which pays for practical support to enable tenants to maintain their tenancies as independently as possible.

Our team of full time Scheme and Community Co-ordinators are based at ateb's sheltered schemes in Pembroke, Milford Haven, Haverfordwest, Narberth and Tenby. They provide support with a range of practical guidance, advice and help both in the sheltered scheme where they are based and in the community.

They provide help and support with:

- Settling into your home and setting up utilities.
- Daily or weekly call or visit.
- Accessing services such as doctor, dentist, hospital.
- Claiming benefits to maximise income.
- Getting involved in your community.
- Debt management and household budgeting.
- Arranging adaptations to help you cope with disability.
- Arranging repairs.
- Organising professional help from other agencies.
- Maintaining good relationships.

Aims of the Sheltered & **Community Support Service**

- You feel safe and secure in your home and within the community.
- You have opportunities to extend your skills, interests and friendships.
- You feel able to manage your home and live in your community with the support provided.
- Your needs are assessed and met in a planned way
- You feel consulted and informed.
- You feel supported by our staff, who receive appropriate training and support.

Service Standards

Everyone who delivers supporting people services at ateb will act professionally and treat you with respect. We will:

- Speak and behave courteously.
- Avoid shouting and unearned familiarity.
- Use the name you wish to be known by.
- Respect your privacy.
